The International Symphony Orchestra of Sarnia and Port Huron is a regional performing arts organization, providing musical presentations and educational initiatives to residents of Lambton County, Ontario and St. Clair County, Michigan. It is a semi-professional orchestra of exceptional artistic quality, comprised of 60+ musicians. Its Music Director is Douglas A. Bianchi, Associate Professor at Wayne State University. The ISO has just celebrated its 60th Anniversary Season, having been guided for 30 of those years by the current Executive Director who is now retiring.

The Executive Director oversees all aspects of the organization and is responsible for the management of human and financial resources needed to achieve the orchestra's mission, in accordance with policies set by the Board of Directors. As such, the Executive Director serves as the public face for the orchestra in community activities and patron/donor relations. The ED's responsibilities call for an individual with demonstrated leadership skills, solid management experience, and a comprehensive musical background to effectually collaborate with artistic personnel so as to ensure the development of the organization's programming.

Demonstrated leadership skills

Knowledge of symphonic orchestral repertoire
